#### ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade on Wednesday remained untested. Packer interest is reported as light with Cargill – High Plains, Alberta, not buying this week due to the floods. The plant itself is not flooded, however the local water treatment plant is closed due to damage from the flooding and Cargill cannot process without a supply of fresh clean water. Once fresh water becomes available, production will resume. Bids in Alberta are currently reported as \$6.00-\$10.00 lower than last week and sellers are not biting. If bids do not improve, light trade is anticipated.

#### U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade remained untested with just a few bids resurfacing at \$117.00 live and \$190.00-\$191.00 dressed while asking prices are firm at \$122.00 live and \$195.00-\$196.00 dressed. At this point it appears that business is going to be delayed until Friday again this week.
