U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S.D.A. Mandatory Price Report for last week listed steers from \$129.00-\$134.00 live averaging \$131.59 up from \$130.93 the previous week while heifers sold from \$129.00-\$133.00 live averaging \$131.72 up from \$131.20 the previous week. On the rail steers traded from \$205.00-\$209.50 averaging \$207.99 up from \$206.44 the previous week while heifers sold from \$205.00-\$209.50 dressed, averaging \$208.30 up from \$206.43. Today the U.S. cash cattle trade remained untested with no bids on the table and asking prices reported at poorly defined. Both buyers and sellers were quiet as they both try to assess the market situation after two days of sharply lower cattle futures.
