ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade on Tuesday remained untested however some light trade could start to surface this afternoon. Canfax reports: "This week's showlist has been compiled with volumes larger than the previous week. With limited sale volumes last week, we are dealing with some carryover numbers this week. Looking at the most recent weekly live cattle export data, Canadian fed cattle and cow exports to the US totaled just over 11,000 head, 5% larger than the same week last year. 2023 will be the largest slaughter cattle export volume since 2014."

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw a couple of thousand head sell in lowa Tuesday at \$175.00 live up \$3.00 from last week but not enough sold to establish a market for the week. Today, bids are starting to surface in the north at \$275.00 dressed, up \$3.00 from last week's weighted average price but sellers are not showing any interest at this time. Asking prices are starting to surface at \$174.00-\$175.00 live in the south while the north remains unestablished.
