### ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

**Alberta direct trade** saw no new trade to report. Showlist volumes are larger than the previous week. Despite the excitement around higher fed cattle prices basis levels remain disappointing. Last week on a cash-to-cash basis, Alberta fed prices were at a \$30.00/cwt discount against the Nebraska market. For the beginning of June, this is one of the weakest basis levels on record. Looking at the calf market, there has been a large offering of forward delivery calves and prices are record high. A lot of the 550lb steer calves are trading on either side of \$6.00/lb. Eastern Canadian feedlot demand has been very strong.

### U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

**The U.S. cash cattle trade** saw no new trade to report. This morning, packer interest remains light and significant trade is likely to be delayed until the second half of this week. Asking prices are not established but are anticipated to start out around \$248.00/cwt live in the North and \$236.00/cwt live in the South. Four state showlist volumes have been reported larger with the largest week over week increase in fed supplies noted in the South. US beef exports for the month of April were 9% lower than last year. Less beef ended up being shipped to Mexico and Taiwan. Beef shipments to China were also down significantly, 66% lower compared to the previous month. This did not come as a big surprise, China still has not renewed export certificates to many US beef plants. YTD beef exports are down 4% compared to last year.
