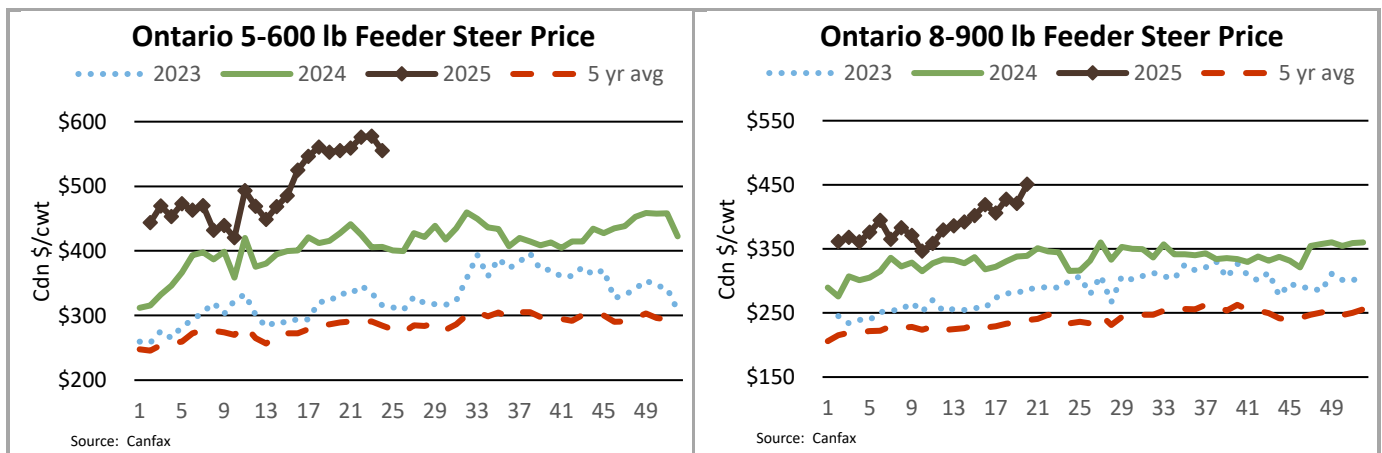

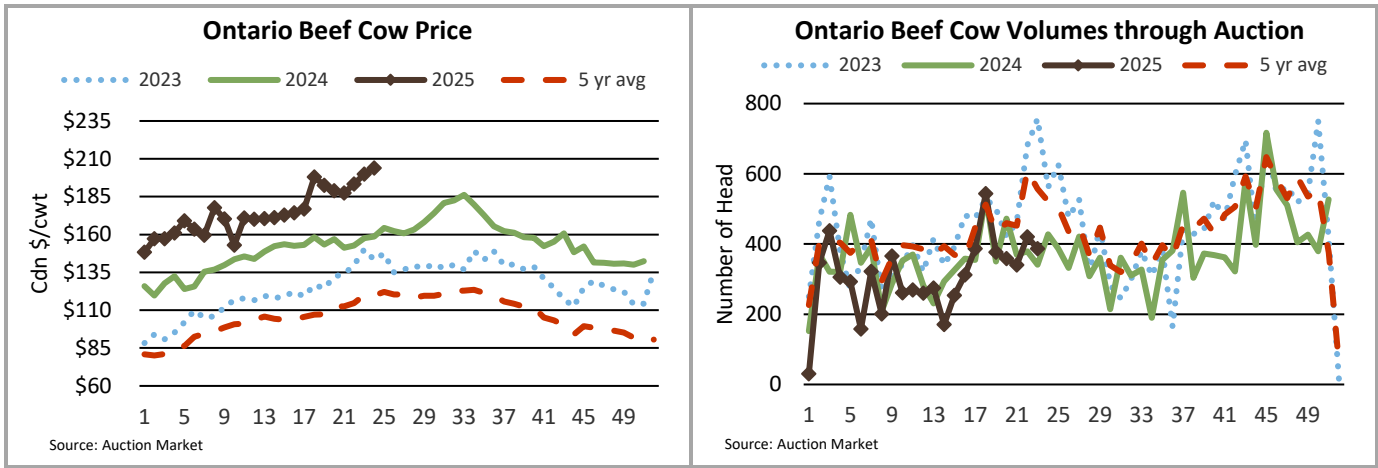

ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade so far this week seen light trade develops with dressed sales ranging from \$502.00-\$504.00/cwt delivered, steady to \$2.00/cwt higher than last week. Cattle that traded were being scheduled anywhere from immediate to the first half of July delivery. Both Western Canadian and US packer interest was supportive this week. The bright spot for the Canadian market fed market was Ontario as dressed sales were \$10.00/cwt stronger. Ontario fed prices are at a premium over the Alberta market.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw light trade was reported in Texas and Kansas yesterday with live sales ranging from \$233.00-238.00/cwt, \$6.00-\$8.00/cwt higher than the previous week. Dressed sales in the North were reported at \$380.00/cwt, while live sales were at \$242.00/cwt, fully steady. Today, light trade is reported in Nebraska at \$242.00/cwt live, while dressed bids are noted at \$380.00/cwt. Looking at the pork market, US pork exports for the month of April were 11% lower than last year. Less pork ended up being shipped to Mexico, Japan and South Korea. Pork is more dependent on exports than beef. Roughly 30% of the pork that is produced is exported whereas beef is around 15%.
