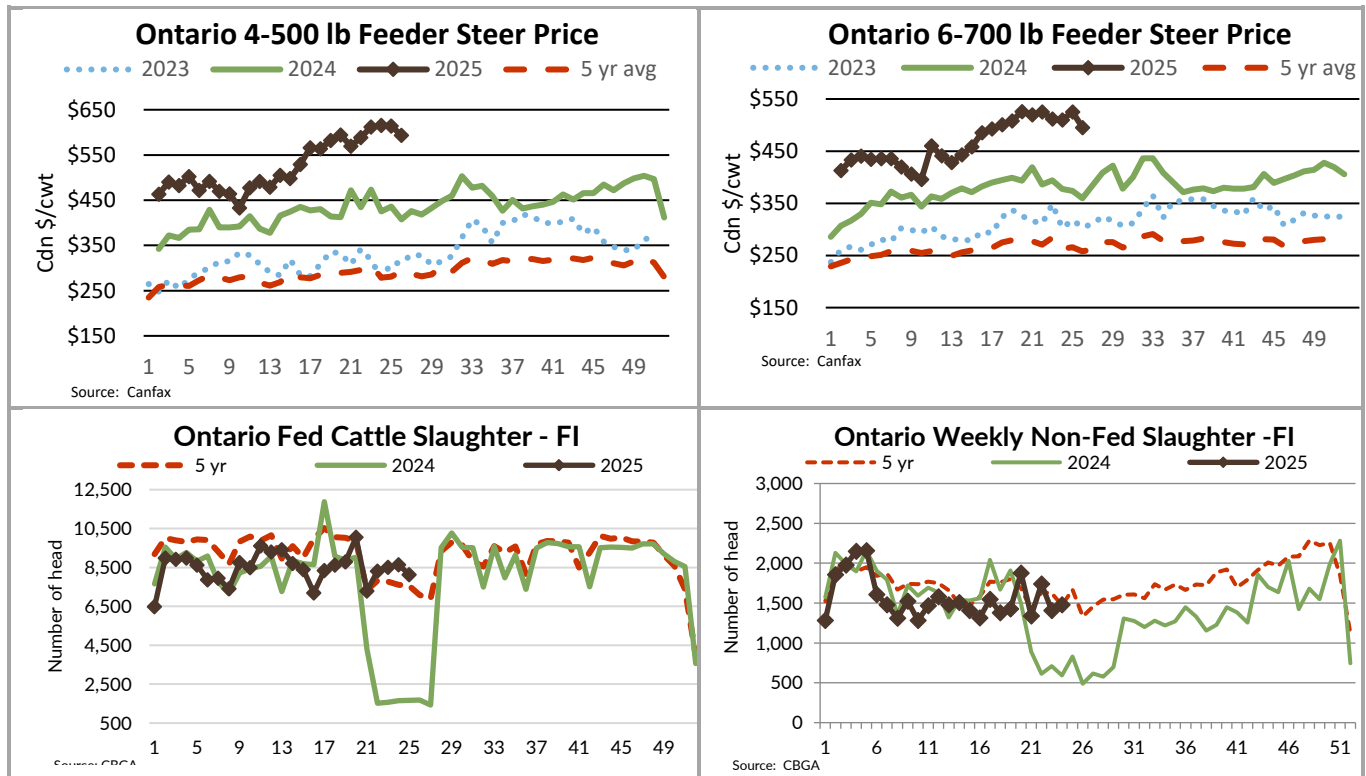

**Alberta direct trade** this week have seen light trade develop with dressed sales ranging from \$498.00-\$503.00/cwt delivered, \$1.00-2.00/cwt lower than the previous week. Live sales have been reported around \$299.00/cwt FOB feedlot, \$0.50/cwt lower than last week's weighted average price. Cattle that traded were being scheduled anywhere from the second half of July to the first half of August delivery. US market interest was quiet on the western Canadian fed market this week and no cash sales were confirmed. Weighted average fed prices closed the week \$1.00/cwt lower.

## U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

**The U.S. cash cattle trade** saw light trade reported in Texas and Kansas yesterday with live sales ranging from \$223.00-\$225.00/cwt, \$5.00-\$6.00/cwt lower than last week. Dressed sales in Iowa and Nebraska were from \$365.00-\$368.00/cwt, \$10.00-11.00/cwt softer. Today, light trade is reported in Nebraska at \$230.00-\$233.00/cwt live, while dressed sales are reported at \$368.00/cwt. US steer carcass weights declined 2lbs to average 931lbs, the smallest carcass weights have been this year. For the middle of June US beef cow processing was the smallest since 2015 while dairy cow processing was the smallest since 2008.
