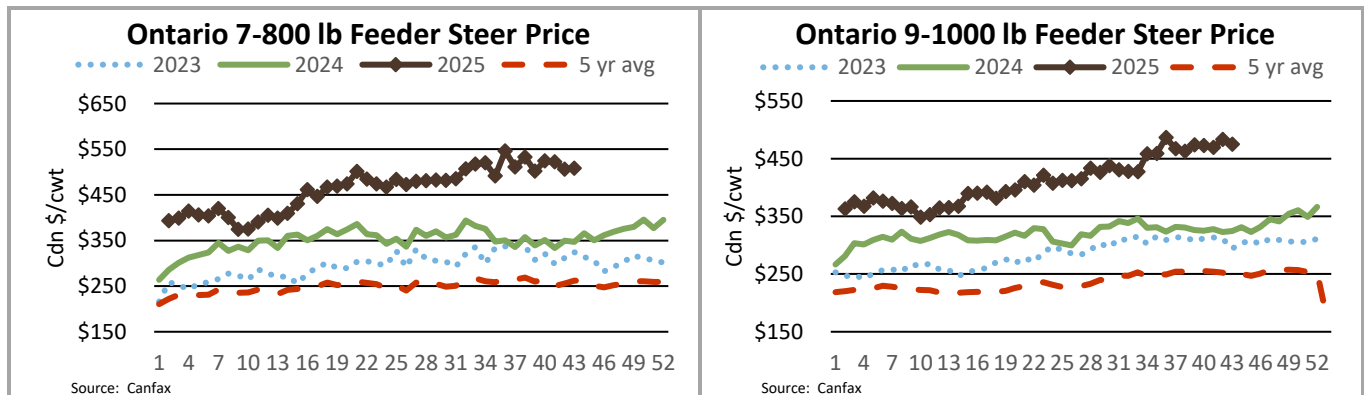

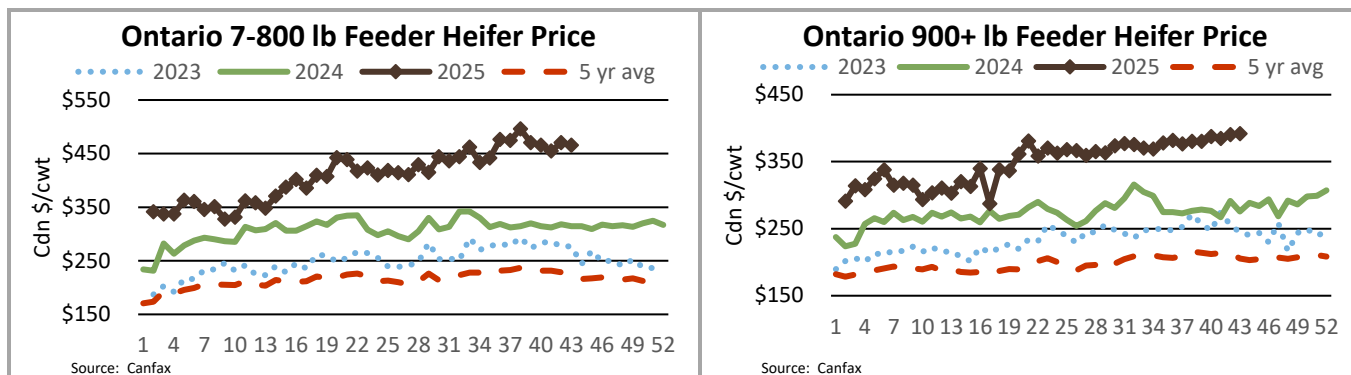

**The U.S. cash cattle trade** saw light trade reported in the northern feeding states yesterday with dressed sales ranging from \$368.00-\$370.00/cwt, \$2.00/cwt lower than last week. Today, light trade was reported in the Northern feeding states from \$238.00-\$239.00/cwt live, \$2.00/cwt lower than last week. Dressed sales were reported at \$370.00/cwt, \$2.00-\$3.00/cwt softer. In the Southern feeding states, live sales were reported at \$238.00/cwt live, \$2.00/cwt lower than the previous week. It has been a tough week for the cattle complex with live and feeder cattle contracts locked down today. The USDA October 1<sup>st</sup> cattle on feed report was unavailable at the time of reporting due to the ongoing US government shutdown.
