



ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade this week have been light trade develop with dressed sales at mostly \$500.00/cwt delivered, \$5.00/cwt higher than the previous week. Cattle that traded were being scheduled anywhere from immediate to the first half of February delivery, depending on the packer. This week's Alberta fed cash-to-futures basis was reported at -\$25.50/cwt, for the first half of January, this is one of the weakest basis levels seen over the past fifteen years. Both Western and Eastern Canadian fed prices are trading at the highest point since the second half of October.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw light trade reported in Iowa and Nebraska with dressed sales ranging from \$360.00-365.00/cwt (mostly \$365/cwt), \$5.00/cwt higher than the previous week. Live sales in the North were at \$232.00/cwt, fully steady. Today, the market tone in the North is steady to a little stronger as live sales have been reported from \$232.50-233.00/cwt. Business in the South has been relatively quiet, but buying interest will improve over the next several hours. So far bids of \$232.00/cwt are being passed. In overseas markets China has announced new beef safeguards. This announcement comes after a one-year investigation into record beef imports from 2022 to 2024. Each country will be given a quota. Imports within that quote will continue at current tariff rates. Export exceeding the quotas will face an additional 55% tariff. This will shift global beef trade. For the time being the US is unable to ship beef into China due to expired export certification, and China has not renewed them.
