U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade last week saw most of the trade took place on Thursday and Friday. Dressed sales in Iowa and Nebraska were at \$365.00/cwt, \$5.00/cwt higher than the previous week. Live sales in all major feeding states ranged from \$232.00-233.00/cwt, steady to \$1.00/cwt stronger. US beef exports for the month of October were 18% lower than last year. Less beef ended up being shipped to China, Mexico and South Korea. YTD US beef exports are down 12% versus 2024.
