ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade last week saw light trade develop with weighted average steer and heifer prices closing the week around \$297.50/cwt, since late November fed prices have rallied \$13.00/cwt. Despite the uptick in prices a lot of the cattle targeting the first quarter fed market have breakevens on either side of \$315.00/cwt, suggesting cattle being sold right now are looking at negative margins. Last week butcher cows averaged around \$216.00/cwt, prices are mostly steady compared to the second half of December. January is traditionally a tough month for the butcher cow market. Over the past five years first half of the year lows have occurred in January. This week's showlist has been compiled with volumes smaller than the previous week.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw light trade was reported in Kansas yesterday with live sales at \$233.00/cwt, sales are positioned the top end of last week's trading range. Today business remains quiet and significant trade will likely be delayed until the second half of the week. Asking prices are poorly defined but are anticipated to start out in the upper \$230's/cwt on a live basis. USDA released its annual crop report yesterday. Corn for grain production was estimated at 17.0 billion bushels, up 269 million bushels from USDA's previous estimate in November. US corn yields were revised at 186.5 bushels per acre. Yields surpassed expectations as many were anticipating lower yields. The near-by corn contract closed 20 cents per bushel lower hitting the lowest point since August. Feeder cattle contracts did react positively to the news.
