The U.S. cash cattle trade last week saw most of the trade took place on Friday. Dressed sales in Iowa and Nebraska were at \$365.00/cwt, steady with the previous week. Live sales in the North were from \$230.00-233.00/cwt, steady to a little weaker. Sales in Texas and Kansas were at \$233.00/cwt, steady. Last week's cattle processed was estimated at 562,000 head, 29,000 head below last year. The Lexington beef plant is idling down production with no cattle being processed ahead of the scheduled January 20th closure date.
