Alberta direct trade on Wednesday saw light trade develop with dressed sales and bids reported from \$505.00-508.00/cwt delivered, fully steady with the previous week. In some instances, packers have been making inquiries looking for extra cattle. US packer interest has been relatively quiet this week. Not only is the market tone steady in Western Canada but steady in Eastern Canada as well. For the time being bids in Eastern Canada are high enough to keep cattle from moving into Eastern Canada for processing.

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw light trade was reported in Iowa yesterday with dressed sales at \$363.00/cwt, steady with prices seen earlier in the week and steady to \$2.00/cwt lower than last week. In general sales volumes are still light and significant trade will likely hold off until Friday. Cooler temperatures are on the way and are expected to cover a wide swath of the US. There have already been talks of processing reductions. Cold temperatures could also impact cattle performance this is supporting the live cattle complex.
