### U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade last week saw most of the trade took place on Friday. Dressed sales in Iowa and Nebraska were from \$375.00-378.00/cwt, \$5.00-8.00/cwt higher than the previous week. Live sales in all four major feeding states were from \$238.00-240.00/cwt, \$3.00-5.00/cwt stronger. USDA released its January 1st cattle inventory report last Friday. Despite strong margins in 2025 the beef industry has been slow to turn the corner and rebuild numbers. On January 1st beef cow inventories were reported at 27.6 million head, 1% lower than last year. Beef cow numbers are the smallest since 1961. Beef heifers kept back for replacements were up 0.9% or 40,000 head, well below industry estimates. Total US cattle inventories were reported just over 86 million head, 320,000 head below last year.
