### ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

**Alberta direct trade** last week saw light trade develop with weighted average steer and heifer prices closing the week around \$306.00/cwt, \$2.50/cwt higher than the previous week. Dressed sales were reported from \$515.00-517.00/cwt delivered. Butcher cows traded \$2.00-4.00/cwt higher through commercial auction facilities. Cow prices are within \$8.00/cwt of their highs set back last May. For cow calf producers one thing to point out and keep an eye on is that LPI calf insurance is now available to purchase. For the middle of October, a producer can lock in a 6-weight steer calf for just over \$3,500.00/head, based on top end coverage and before the premium. ### U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

**The U.S. cash cattle trade** saw no new trade reported yesterday, and significant trade will likely be delayed until the second half of this week. Asking prices are poorly defined but are expected to start out around \$243.00/cwt on a live basis. Four state showlist volumes have been reported smaller. Touching on the January 1st cattle inventory report again. Beef cow inventories continue to decline but the story is much different for the dairy sector. US dairy cows were reported at 9.8 million head, 190,000 head larger than last year. Dairy cow inventories are the largest since the early 1990's.
