## ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

**Alberta direct trade** on Tuesday saw no new trade to report. Asking prices are reported anywhere from \$525.00-530.00/cwt delivered. US buying interest were noted, with live bids at \$323.00/cwt CDN delivered. Butcher cow prices looked stronger through commercial auction facilities this week, this will hopefully lend support to the fed cattle market. In November Canadian feeder cattle imports from the US totaled 80,000 head, the second largest import volume on record. In 2025 Canada is on track to be a net importer of feeder cattle by roughly 425,000 head. Tighter cattle supplies in Canada and growing feedlot capacity in Western Canada has supported demand for US feeder cattle.

## U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

**The U.S. cash cattle trade** saw no trade reported yesterday. Significant trade will likely hold off until Thursday or Friday. Last Friday the Trump administration signed a deal with Argentina, expanding its beef import quota by 80,000 metric tons. According to the agreement Argentina is permitted to export 20,000 metric tons on a quarterly basis and any un-used quota will not be carried forward. It also clarifies that this is only for lean beef trim, primarily from cows. With the deal in place, US beef imports from Argentina could double in 2026. With that said Argentina is still a relatively small supplier of beef to the US and likely won't have a significant impact on the market.
