ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade on Wednesday saw light trade develop with dressed sales ranging from \$520.00-525.00/cwt delivered and a few have traded at \$515.00/cwt FOB the feedlot. Dressed sales are \$3.00-8.00/cwt higher than the previous week. Buying interest has been noted from all western Canadian packers. US packer interest has been noted, and live bids are in the CDN mid \$320's/cwt delivered to the US. Canadian beef imports for the month of November were 11% larger than last year. Beef imports from Australia were strong, running above last year and the five-year average. YTD (January to November 2025) Australia is Canada's second largest import market accounting for 20% of total Canadian beef imports.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw light trade was reported in Kansas yesterday with live sales at \$243.00/cwt, fully steady with the previous week. Other than light trade in Kansas business remains quiet in all other feeding states. Fed cattle prices have strengthened over the past couple of weeks, yet wholesale beef prices have chopped sideways, pushing packer margins further into the red. Beef cutout values remain historically strong relative to pork and chicken prices. From a procurement standpoint both retailers and the food service sector have been slow to step out and buy inventory out front. Forward beef sales have been disappointing to start the year off. Over the past four weeks forward beef sales for 22-90-day delivery are down 22% versus last year.
