### ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

**Alberta direct trade** last week saw light trade develop with weighted average steer and heifer price closing the week around \$319.50/cwt, \$1.00/cwt higher than the previous week. Alberta fed basis levels did strengthen last week, basis levels are now stronger than the five-year average. Butcher cows traded \$1.00-2.00/cwt higher through commercial auction facilities last week. YTD Western Canadian cow processing is down 18% compared to last year. This is the third smallest cow processing volume on record, the only years that were smaller were in 2004 and 2005. This week's showlist volumes are smaller than the previous week.

### U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

**The U.S. cash cattle trade** saw no new trade reported yesterday. Significant trade will likely be delayed until the second half of this week. Asking prices are poorly defined but are expected to start out in the mid \$240's/cwt on a live basis. Showlist volumes are smaller in the North and larger in the Southern feeding states. Reduced processing volumes have supported the beef complex. It is important to highlight strength behind the cutout is not demand driven but rather supply driven. With labor issues at the Greely Co processing plant it is expected they will not be active on the cash market this week.
