### ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

**Alberta direct trade** last week saw light trade develop with weighted average steer and heifer prices closing the week around \$352.00/cwt, \$8.00/cwt higher than the previous week. Both local and US packer interest has been supportive. Last week butcher cows traded \$1.00-2.00/cwt lower through commercial auction facilities. For the week ending May 23rd Western Canadian cow carcass weights averaged 919lbs, a new record high. a large percentage of the cows entering the processing mix are coming out of feedlots. From a seasonal perspective cow prices traditionally peak during the first half of June.

### U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

**The U.S. cash cattle trade** saw no new trade to report. Today, very light trade is reported in Southern feeding states at \$255.00/cwt live, \$1.00-2.00/cwt lower than the previous week. Significant trade will likely be delayed until the second half of this week. Showlist volumes have been reported smaller in Nebraska and Colorado. Beef cutout values have struggled to gain traction but the same can be said for the pork market. Pork cutout values usually trend higher driven by belly and ham primal values, however, that has not been the case so far. Pork cutout values are trading below last year and below the five-year average. Weaker wholesale pork prices have weighed on the futures market, the June lean hog contract is trading near \$95/cwt, the lowest point since December.
