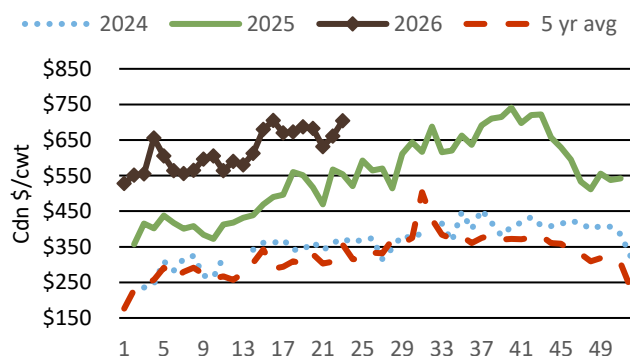

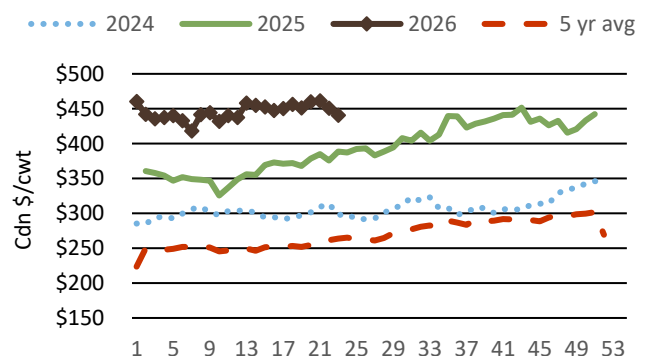

**Ontario 3-400 lb Feeder Heifer Price**

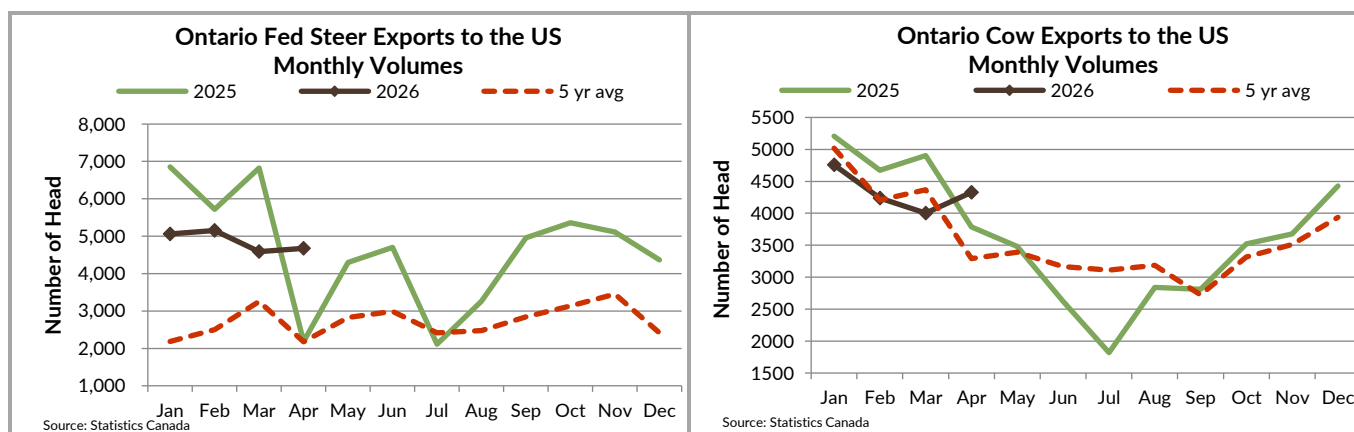

## ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

**Alberta direct trade** this week have seen light trade develop with dressed sales ranging from \$575.00-590.00/cwt delivered, steady to \$5.00/cwt lower than last week. All three Western Canadian packers bought cattle this week. Cattle that traded would be picked up anywhere from 1-6 weeks. Sales at the top end of this week's range would be picked up in 1-2 weeks. Cattle from Saskatchewan are coming west into Alberta for processing. Canadian barley prices have strengthened while US corn prices have been lower in recent weeks. US feedlots now have a sizable cost of gain advantage over western Canada. US corn is now being booked and delivered into Southern Alberta.

## U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

**The U.S. cash cattle trade** has been limited, with a few cattle traded in the Northern feeding states at \$402.00/cwt dressed, \$2.00/cwt lower than the bulk of sales seen last week. Today, live bids of \$255.00/cwt have been reported in all major feeding areas. Dressed sales in Nebraska are reported from \$404.00-405.00/cwt. With reduced cow processing volumes and record high trim prices, the US has and continues to be a magnet for overseas beef imports. YTD beef imports from Brazil, Australia, Paraguay, Argentina, Uruguay, and Mexico are all running above last year.
