ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade last week saw light trade develop with weighted average steer and heifer price closing the week around \$348.00/cwt, \$2.00/cwt lower than the previous week. From a seasonal perspective leverage continues to favor the cattle feeder while on the flip side, packers continue to further scale back hours to manage tighter cattle supplies. Asking prices this week are starting out in the \$595-600/cwt delivered area. Butcher cows traded mostly steady through commercial auction facilities. Late last week JBS announced the planned closure of their beef production facility in Souderton Pennsylvania. No timelines were given in the press release. This is expected to have an impact on the Eastern Canadian fed market as Souderton was a regular bidder and buyer of Eastern Canadian fed cattle.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw no new trade to report. Significant trade will likely be delayed until the second half of this week. Asking prices are poorly defined but are expected to start out around \$260.00/cwt on a live basis. Four state showlist volumes have been reported larger. Looking at the grain market. The weather and war premium has come out of the market. Last weeks World Supply and Demand report was also viewed as bearish. From a global perspective corn production remains historically large with record production forecasted for Brazil. From their recent highs in May the December corn contract has declined sixty cents per bushel.
