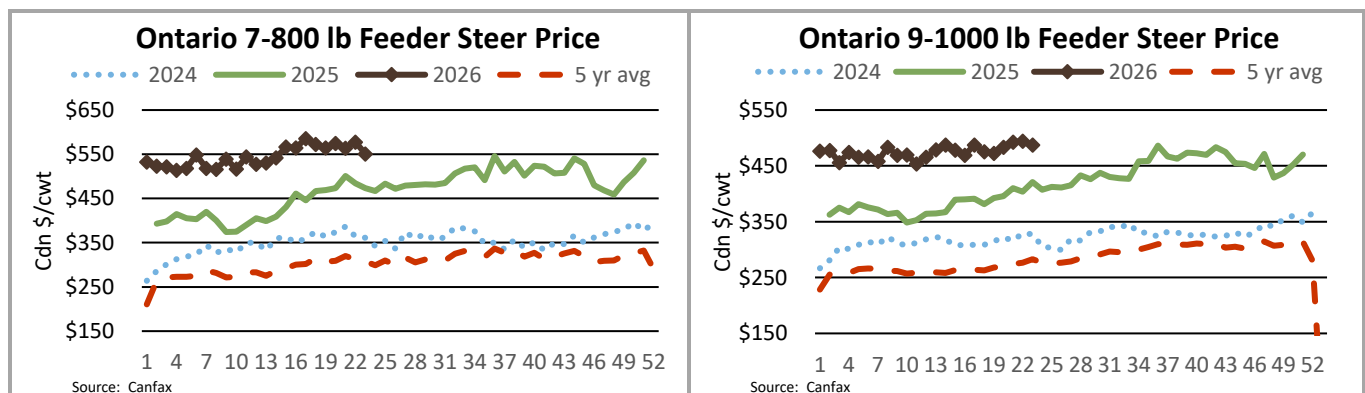

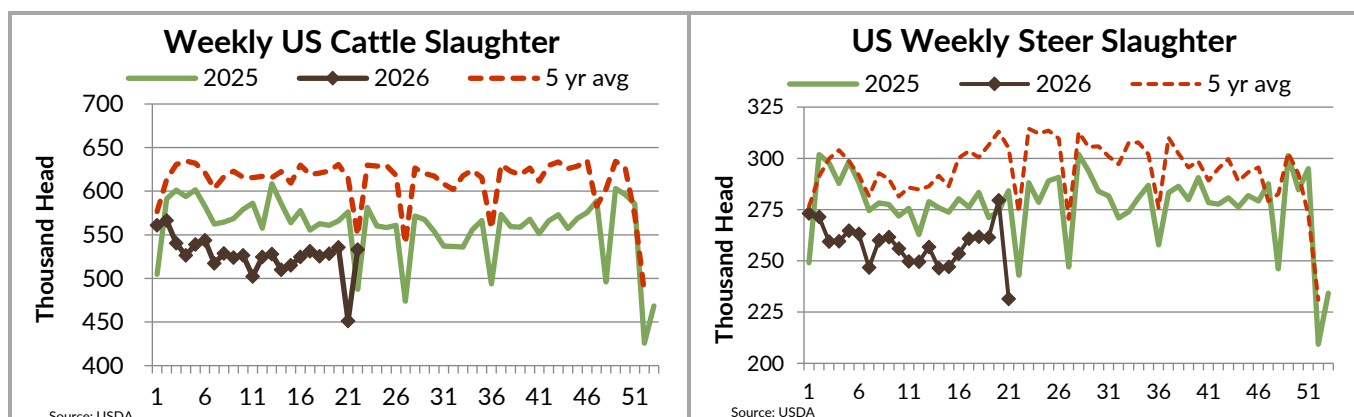

ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade this week have seen light trade develop with dressed sales ranging from \$590.00-592.00/cwt delivered, \$2-15/cwt higher than the previous week. Cattle that traded would be picked up anywhere from 1-6 weeks. Buying interest was from the US was relatively quiet this week. Looking at the feed grain market, barley prices have come under pressure. Weakness in the corn complex and generally good moisture conditions across the Prairies has weighted on domestic prices. Spot barley prices have dropped \$20.00+/tonne and new crop barley prices have softened \$8.00-12.00/tonne.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw live bids at \$254.00/cwt yesterday in all major feeding states, but no cattle ended up trading. Bids are \$1.00-2.00/cwt lower than the previous week. Packers have bought very few cattle. Today live bids of \$254.00/cwt have been renewed, selling interest continues to be limited. Dressed bids in the North have been reported up to \$405.00/cwt, bids are steady with last week. US cow prices have moved higher since the start of the year. Despite drought conditions across parts of the US, beef cow processing volumes continue to be historically small. Both US cow and 90% trim prices are holding near record highs.
