ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade on Monday saw no new trade to report. Showlist volumes are larger than the previous week. From a supply perspective there are a few yearlings around but fed calf volumes continue to increase. Packers are short bought and buying interest on the cash market has been good. The Canadian beef retail prices for the month of April was reported at \$28.00/kg, down from March but 15% higher than last year. Retail pork and chicken prices also declined from March to April. Retail pork values are the lowest in ten months.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw no new trade to report. Significant trade will likely be delayed until the second half of this week. Asking prices are poorly defined but are expected to start out in the low to mid \$260's/cwt on a live basis. Showlist volumes have been reported larger in all major feeding states. New World screwworm cases in the US continue to edge higher. The US has now reported 15 cases total. This number is expected to grow especially over the next couple of months. In overseas markets there have been reports Australia has filled its 205,000/tonne beef quota to China. Australian beef shipments into China will now face a 55% tariff for the balance of 2026.
