ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade on Tuesday saw no new trade to report but there is a good chance scattered trade will develop by this afternoon. Western Canadian fed processing volumes remain historically small yet over the past five weeks Canadian live cattle exports to the US (fed cattle and cows) are 12,000 head larger than last year. The Canadian dollar remains under pressure, trading at the lowest point in fourteen months. The softer Canadian dollar should bode well for Canadian beef exports.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade so far this week has seen light trade reported in Iowa and Nebraska with live sales at \$260.00/cwt. Sales are positioned at the top end of last week's trading range. Dressed sales in the Northern feeding states were at \$408.00/cwt, fully steady. Business in the Southern feeding states has been quiet with no bids to speak of. Yesterday, beef cutout values had a strong day closing \$4.00-5.00/cwt higher. Choice cutouts are within \$3.00/cwt of their highs, set back in March. Pork cutout values have struggled and are trading roughly 20% below last year. Pork cutout values are trading not too far off annual price lows.
