ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade last week saw light trade develop with weighted average steer and heifer price closing the week around \$357.00/cwt, \$1.00/cwt higher than the previous week. Setting new annual highs yet again. Over the past 50 years annual highs have never occurred in July. Butcher cows traded \$1.00-2.00/cwt lower through commercial auction facilities last week. Moisture conditions remain good across much of the Prairies and non-fed volumes are expected to be light over the next 30-45 days. Most of the cows entering the processing mix are coming out of feedlots as cow carcass weights are record large.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw no new trade to report, and significant trade will likely hold off until the second half of this week. Packers are buying for a full processing week. Asking prices are poorly defined but are expected to start out in the upper \$250's/cwt on a live basis. Four state showlist volumes have been reported larger. New World Screwworm cases in the US continue to tick higher. At the start of July there were 21 active animal cases in the US. Just to highlight in Central America and Mexico there were more than 185,000 animal cases and over 2,000 cases in people.
