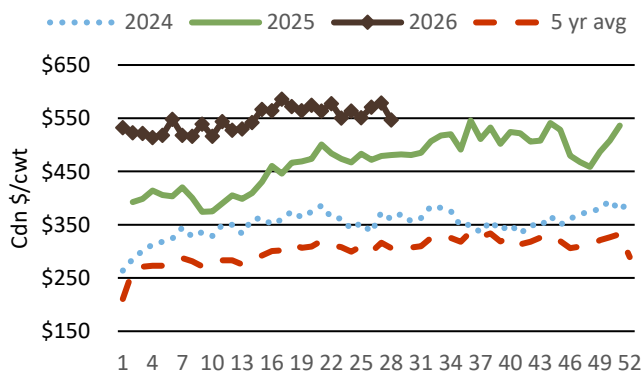

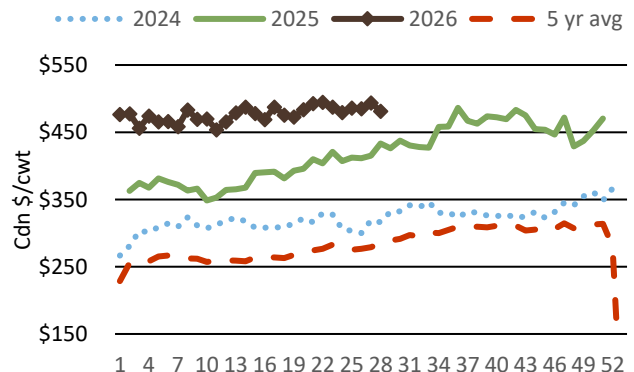

Ontario 7-800 lb Feeder Steer Price

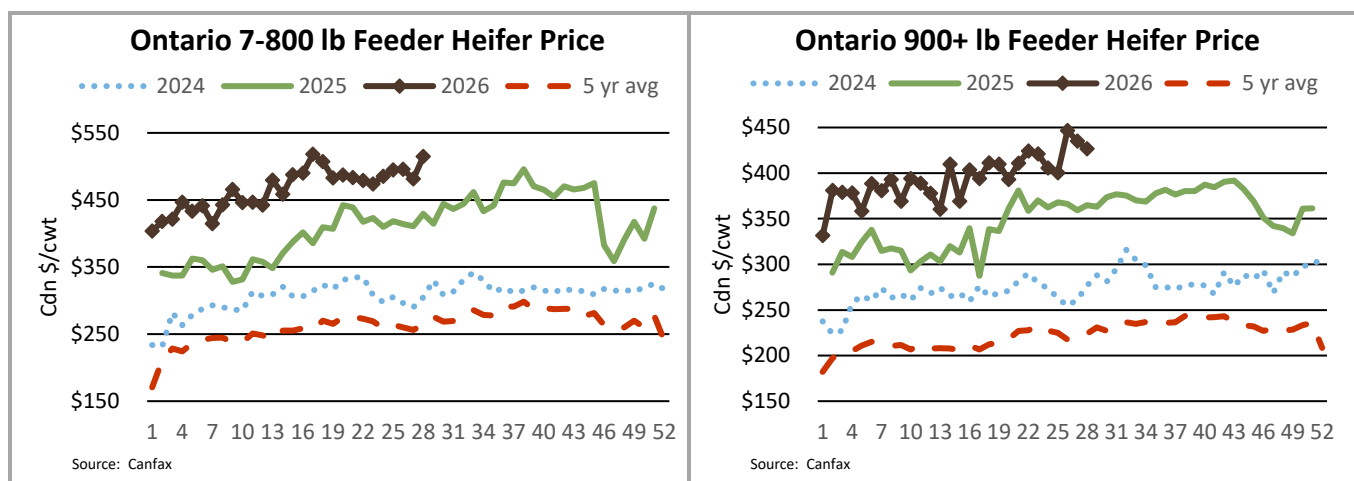

Alberta direct trade this week have seen light trade develop with dressed sales ranging from \$565.00-575.00/cwt delivered, \$15.00-17.00/cwt lower than the previous week. All western Canadian packers bought cattle and lift times were all over the map. Cattle that traded were schedule for delivery anywhere from the first half of August to the first half of September. Small premiums were being paid for Chinese eligible cattle. US packer interest was noted but few if any cattle traded south.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw light trade reported in Iowa and Nebraska yesterday with dressed sales ranging from \$370.00-375.00/cwt, \$3.00-5.00/cwt lower than prices seen on Wednesday and \$18.00-20.00/cwt lower than last week. Live sales in Texas and Kansas were from \$235.00-238.00/cwt, \$10.00-13.00/cwt lower. Fed cattle prices are at the lowest point since late March. Live cattle contracts continue to drift lower. Since the middle of June deferred live cattle contracts have dropped \$20.00/cwt and are trading at 7-month lows. To a large degree the market seems oversold.
