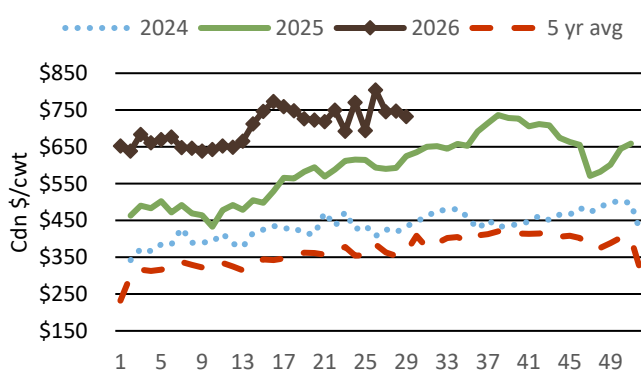

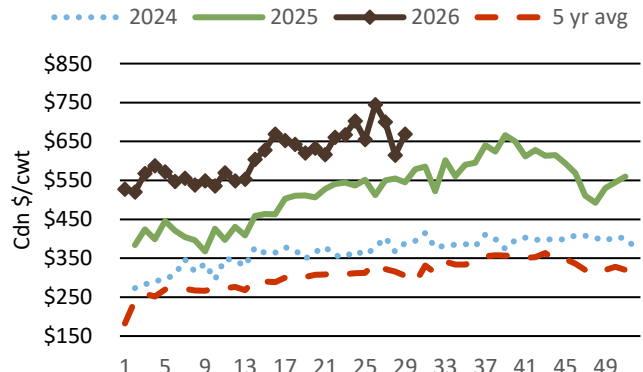

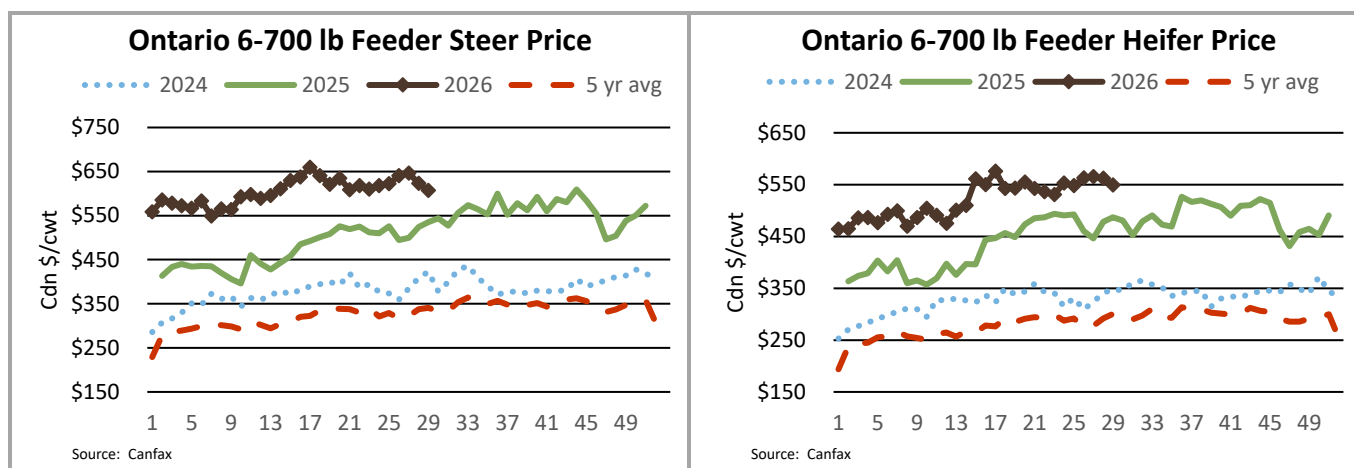

Alberta direct trade this week have seen light trade develop with dressed sales at mostly \$550.00/cwt delivered, \$15.00-25.00/cwt lower than last week. Cattle that traded were scheduled for delivery through out August and September. Over the past month fed prices have dropped \$50.00/cwt on a dressed basis or roughly \$450.00/head. When dressed sales were at \$600.00/cwt delivered, feedlot margins were positive however, with the recent pull back feedlot margins are now negative.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw light trade reported in Iowa and Nebraska yesterday with dressed sales at \$365.00/cwt, \$8.00-20.00/cwt lower than the previous. Live sales in Texas and Kansas were at \$230.00/cwt, \$8.00/cwt lower. USDA July 1st cattle on feed report released this afternoon shows total cattle on feed at 11.4 million head, 2% above last year, placements total 1.40 million head, down 3% from a year ago and marketings total 1.66 million head, also down 3% from 2025.
