U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw scattered trade over the course of the week. Dressed sales in Iowa and Nebraska were from \$365.00-375.00/cwt (mostly \$365.00/cwt) \$8.00-20.00/cwt lower than the previous week. Live sales in all major feeding areas were from \$230.00-232.00/cwt, \$7.00-10.00/cwt lower. Fed cattle prices are at the lowest point since the beginning of the year. On Friday it was announced the US plans on a phased re-opening of the of the Southern ports allowing feeder cattle from Mexico to re-enter the US. The-re-opening of the port is scheduled for August 24th. The first port that will open will be in Douglas Arizona. The border has been closed to Mexican feeder cattle for a year and a half now. Today feeder cattle contracts are trading 400-800 points lower.
