Comments for the week ending Oct 1, 2009

The fed cattle market was steady to slightly higher this week. There were 1,123 fed cattle sold through auction markets up 225 from last week and 210 more than last year at this time. Steers sold from \$74.56-\$86.73 averaging \$81.08 up \$1.12 from last week and \$14.41 lower than last year at this time. Heifers traded from \$73.35-\$83.59 averaging \$79.24 up \$0.27 from last week and \$12.99 lower than year ago prices. Auction markets reported active to strong trade with prices from steady to \$1.00 higher with one report of second cut cattle under pressure.

The slaughter cow market saw larger volumes with easier prices. There were 2,882 slaughter cows sold through auction markets up 875 from last week and 646 more than the same time last year. Slaughter cows sold from \$32.10-\$46.69 averaging \$39.39 down \$1.81 from last week and \$11.97 lower than the same time last year. Auction markets reported sales steady last weekend. As the week progressed sales were reported as under pressure with prices easier to \$3.00 lower.

There were 8,055 replacements sold through auction markets up 2.8% from last week and 5% less than the same time last year. Auction markets reported good quality grass type and yearling cattle as trading actively on good demand with prices from steady to stronger with one report of heifers up \$1.00-\$2.00. Medium quality and plainer types were reported as under pressure. Good quality calves were reported as steady to slightly stronger with medium quality and plainer types also under pressure.

Ontario railgrade prices started the week at lower levels than last week, but held steady throughout the week. Steers traded from \$134.00-\$137.00 dressed while heifers were reported from \$133.00-\$136.00 dressed, averaging \$1.50 lower than last week.

Alberta’s fed cattle market was steady to slightly stronger than last week. Steers traded from \$80.65-\$82.00 live and \$134.00-\$135.85 flat rail. Heifers sold at \$80.65 live and \$134.00-\$135.85 flat rail.

U.S. cash cattle trade on Thursday was moderate to active in all areas with prices \$1.50 lower on live sales at \$83.00 live and dressed business \$2.00-\$3.00 lower from 127.00-\$128.00.
