Comments for the week ending May 5, 2016

There were 523 fed steers and heifers sold through auction markets this week down 70 head from last week, but 55 more than this time last year. Fed steers sold from \$137.38-\$157.38 averaging \$147.69 down \$0.69 from last week, and \$50.33 below last year at this time. Fed heifers ranged from \$136.30-\$157.17 averaging \$146.53 down \$2.77 from last week and \$41.06 below year ago prices. Auction market reports started out this reporting period steady to under pressure. As the week progressed the fancy and good quality cattle were called steady, while medium quality and heavier cattle sold under pressure at lower prices.

The Ontario railgrade market started out steady to the end of the previous week, and has held fully steady. Steers traded from \$248.00-\$255.00 dressed with heifers from \$247.00-\$254.00. Delivery was anywhere from this week to the last week in May. This week's average prices are \$7.00 lower than last week on average, (as last week saw prices decline daily) and \$77.25 below last year at this time.

The Canadian Boxed Beef market reported by Kevin Greer for the week of May 2nd notes: "The U.S. Cutout tanked last week and that coupled with the stronger CDN dollar meant that pricing in Canada was under sharp pressure. The Canadian market continues to be sluggish with retail and foodservice movement seasonally slow, however retailers appear to be getting more aggressive." Beef features this week were poor with only four out of nine major retailers featuring beef.

2,060 cull cows sold through auction markets this week down 539 head from last week and 406 more than this time last year. Cull cows traded from \$71.00-\$95.29 averaging \$82.46 down \$1.70 from last week and \$37.20 below last year at this time. Auction markets reported trade as barely steady, to steady on a selective demand. As the week progressed the market was about steady to steady and ended the week slightly stronger.

Lighter receipts of 6,449 replacement cattle sold through auction markets this week down 1,773 head from last week and 883 less than last year at this time. Auction markets reported a good demand this week with calves barely steady early week, to fully steady as the week progressed, with grass weights selling at a premium, at prices better than expected. Heavier cattle started out barely steady to steady. As the week progressed trade was under pressure, but ended the week fully steady, with just the heavier steers up \$3.00-\$5.00 on a strong demand. Actual average prices this week saw steers 400-500 lbs average \$12.41 below last week on average, steers 500-600 lbs up \$0.05, 600-700 lbs up \$6.50, 700-800 lbs u \$1.28, 800-900 lbs down \$2.59, 900-1000 lbs up \$3.47 and steers over 1000 lbs averaging \$2.78 lower than last week. Heifers 300-400 lbs were down \$2.51 from last week on average, 400-500 lbs down \$8.72, 500-600 lbs up \$0.10, 600-700 lbs up \$8.31, 700-800 lbs up \$3.04, 800-900 lbs up \$0.23 and heifers 900 lbs plus averaged \$0.29 lower than last week on average.

The Quebec Electronic Market this week sold from \$244.00-\$247.00 down \$4.40 from last week on average.

The Alberta cash cattle trade was under severe pressure this week with dressed steers averaging \$17.91 below last week. Canfax reported steers at \$151.40 live and \$256.00-\$258.50 dressed down from last week's weighted average of \$275.88. Canfax reported: "light trade developed with dressed sales anywhere from 5.00-20.00 lower than the previous week. The way things are shaping up, this is going to be the largest week to week decline seen in the past five years. Cash to futures basis levels did weaken this week."

The U.S. cash cattle trade for the week ending April 28th, reported by the USDA Mandatory Price Report, lists live sales from \$120.00-\$125.00 with steers averaging \$123.79 down \$2.66 from the previous week on average, while heifers averaged \$123.75 down \$2.95. On the rail sales ranged from \$188.00-\$197.00 dressed with steers averaging \$194.16 down \$6.52 from the week before, while heifers averaged \$195.18 down \$6.53. This week, at time of reporting, a couple of sales have surfaced this afternoon at \$196.00 dressed in the north which is \$2.00 higher than last week on average, but for the most part it appears that most sellers are resisting these bids and holding out for even higher prices. Bids in the south are currently sitting at \$124.00-\$126.00 live which is steady to \$2.00 higher than last week's market. Bids in the north are sitting at \$195.00-\$198.00 dressed which is steady to \$3.00 higher than last week. Asking prices are firm at this time, at \$127.00 live and \$200.00 dressed. Active trade should develop at any time.
