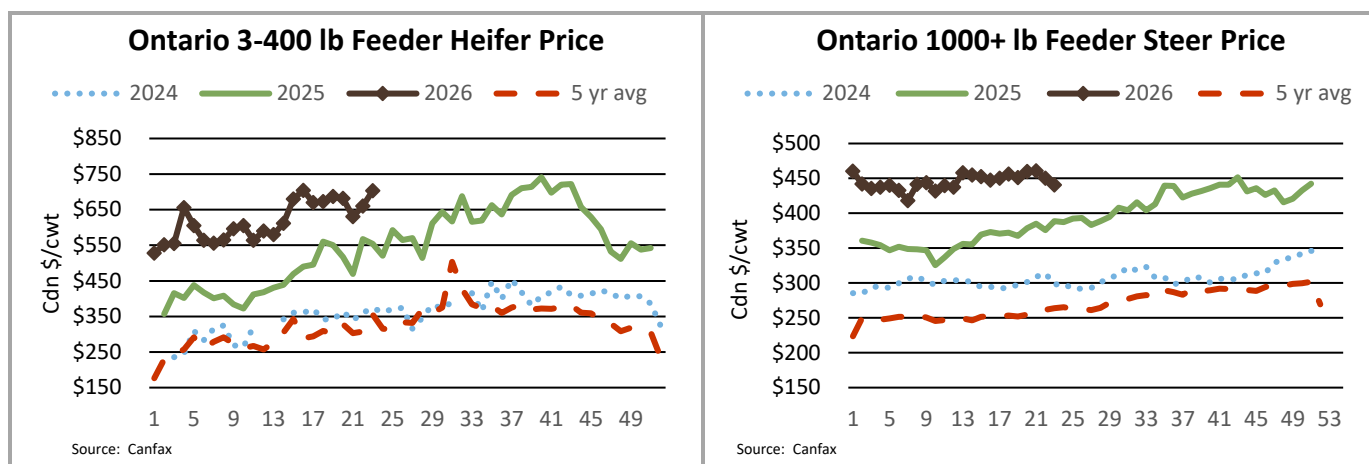

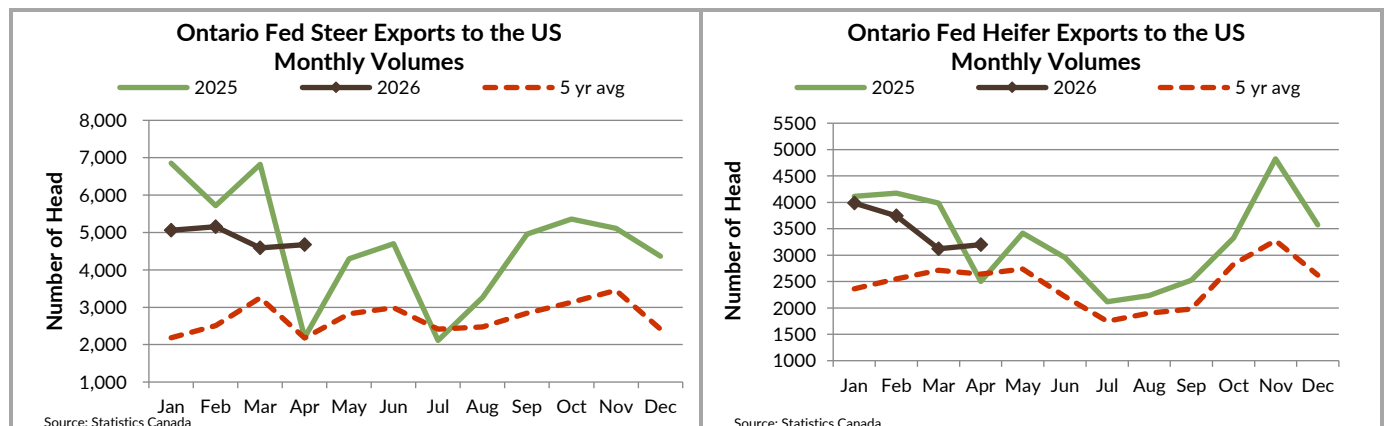

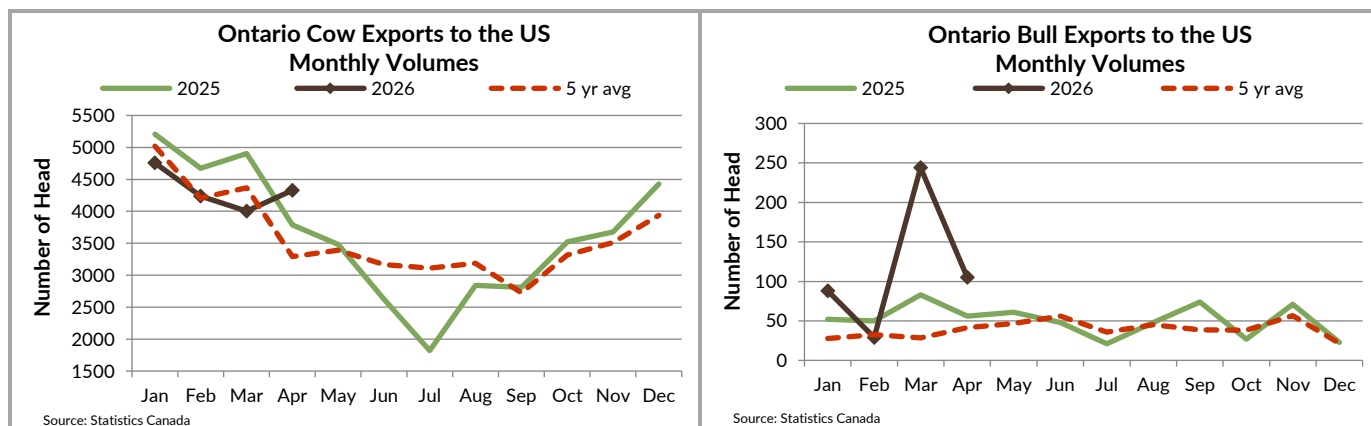

Comments for the week ending June 11, 2026

Fed steers and heifers sold through auction markets at 843 head, were up 248 head from the previous week and 287 head larger than the same time last year. Fed steers averaged \$340.63/cwt, down \$2.00/cwt from the previous week's trade and \$35.27/cwt above year ago prices. Fed heifers averaged \$342.75/cwt, up \$3.21/cwt from the previous week and \$32.03/cwt higher than last year. Auction markets reported that fed steers and heifers sold actively \$2.00-3.00/cwt higher.

In Ontario dressed sales have been reported at \$570/cwt delivered, steady with last week. Cattle are being booked for late June delivery. For the week ending June 6, 2026, Eastern Canadian processing was down 6.3% from a year ago and 1.2% higher than the five-year average. YTD processing is down 2% from a year ago, with steers down 3% and heifers up 2%, cows down 5% and bulls down 22%. For the week ending May 30, 2026, Eastern fed cattle and cow exports to the U.S. were 2,957 head, 19% below last year and 18% above the five-year average. YTD Eastern fed cattle and cow exports were down 2% from last year.

Cull cow receipts sold through auction markets were 1,660 head, 283 head larger than the previous week and down 176 head from last year. Cows averaged \$221.86/cwt, up \$2.55/cwt from the previous week and up \$34.93/cwt from last year. Beef cow prices averaged \$240.00/cwt, up \$9.68/cwt from the previous week's trade and \$36.19/cwt above year ago prices. Auction markets reported that cull cows and drop calves traded steady to stronger.

Total receipts were 7,763 head with receipts of 3,084 stocker and feeder cattle selling through Ontario auction markets, down 1,601 head from the previous week and 56 head less than the same week last year. Auction markets reported that feeder cattle sold on a steady market. A light run of stockers sold exceptionally strong with light weight heifers fetching premiums. In the feeder market, steer prices were down \$19.35/cwt on average compared to last week with heifers up \$7.73 /cwt. Actual average prices collected this week saw steers from 400-500 lbs trading \$56.93/cwt weaker than last week on average, 500-600 lbs down \$19.88/cwt, 600-700 lbs down \$8.01/cwt, 700-800 lbs down \$26.80/cwt, 800-900 lbs down \$7.38/cwt, steers 900-1000 lbs down \$6.76/cwt and steers 1000 lbs plus averaged \$9.72/cwt weaker than the previous week's weighted average prices. Heifers from 300-400 lbs were up \$43.14/cwt from last week on average, 400-500 lbs up \$6.85/cwt, 500-600 lbs up \$20.25/cwt, 600-700 lbs down \$5.23/cwt, 700-800 lbs down \$5.40/cwt, 800-900 lbs down \$2.29/cwt and heifers 900 lbs and over averaged \$3.21/cwt weaker than the previous week's weighted average prices. For the week ending May 30, 2026, Eastern feeder exports to the U.S. were 611 head, 20% lower than last year and 2% above the five-year average. YTD Eastern feeder exports are down 3% from last year.

The Quebec electronic market this week sold at \$569.50-569.50/cwt dressed on a picked-up basis, up \$0.75/cwt from the previous week's trade on average.

Alberta direct trade last week saw dressed sales from \$580-590/cwt delivered. Butcher cows traded \$1-3/cwt higher through commercial auction facilities. Based on the five-year average, cow prices traditionally peak during the first half of June. The forward delivery calf market was lightly tested, B.C, AB, and SK, 600-699 lb steers for fall/early winter delivery traded from \$636-695/cwt, with a weighted average price \$652.97/cwt based at 634 lbs. For the week ending June 6, 2026, Western Canadian fed processing was 30,163 head. YTD processing is 16.5% lower than last year.

U.S. trade last week saw dressed sales in Iowa and Nebraska from \$401-410/cwt (mostly \$405/cwt). Live sales in the North were from \$256-258/cwt, steady to \$1/cwt weaker. Sales in Texas and Kansas were from \$255-258/cwt, anywhere from \$1/cwt lower to \$1/cwt higher compared to the previous week. Choice cutout values closed the week \$0.34/cwt higher, while Select cutout values were down \$2.54/cwt. With the upcoming Father's Day holiday and FIFA World Cup, this should be supportive for cutout values. 73% ground beef was down 5.2% from last week and down 0.8% from last year, whereas Fatty 50% trim was up 4.9% from last week and 45% stronger than last year.

US Department of Agriculture confirmed two additional cases of screwworm, raising concerns around spread and containment efforts. One case was in a dog, and another one was in a calf. A case of New World screwworm was found in Zavala County in southern Texas, 40-50 miles from the US-Mexico border. According to news sources, an immediate and coordinated response was initiated by both USDA and Texas state officials to contain the disease. On June 5th, CFIA announced temporary import restrictions on cattle and horses originating from Texas or that have been in Texas within the past 21 days.
