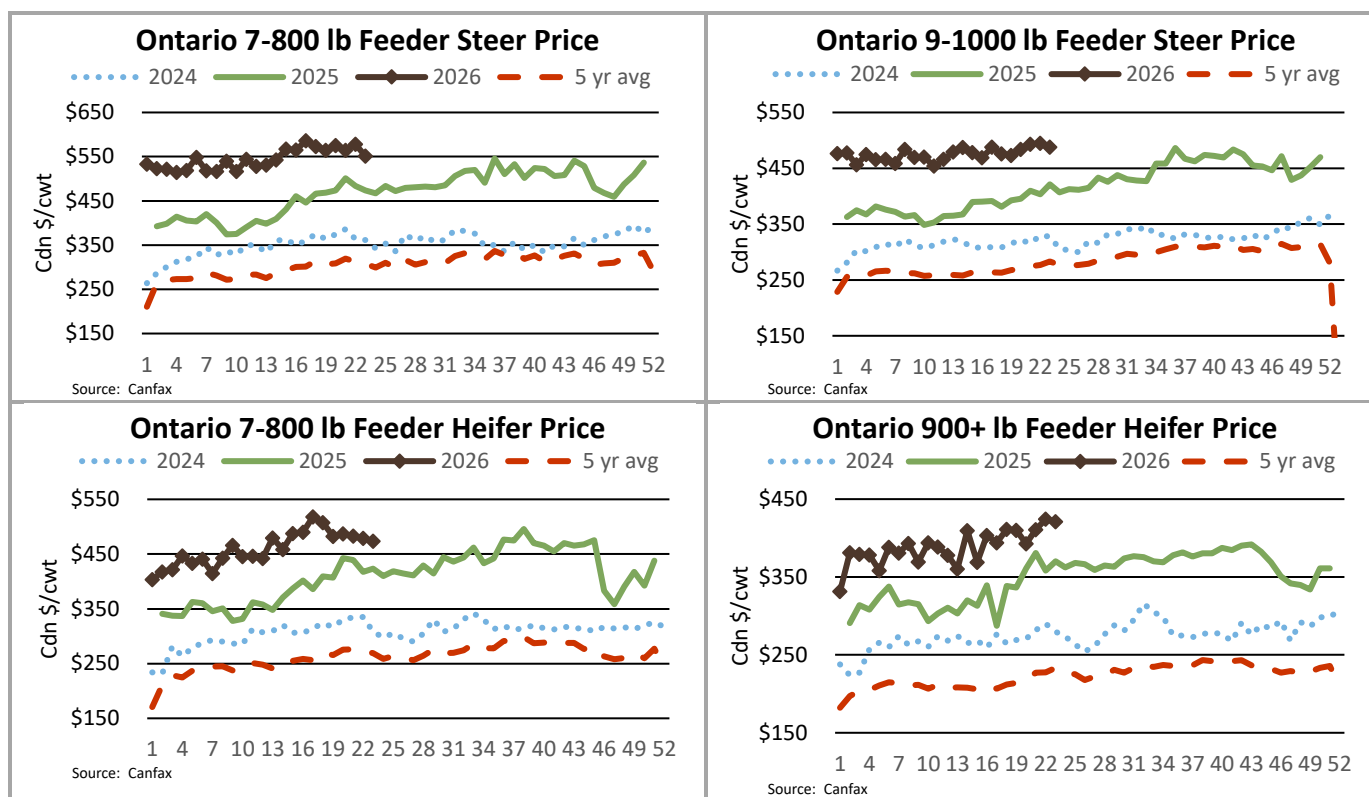

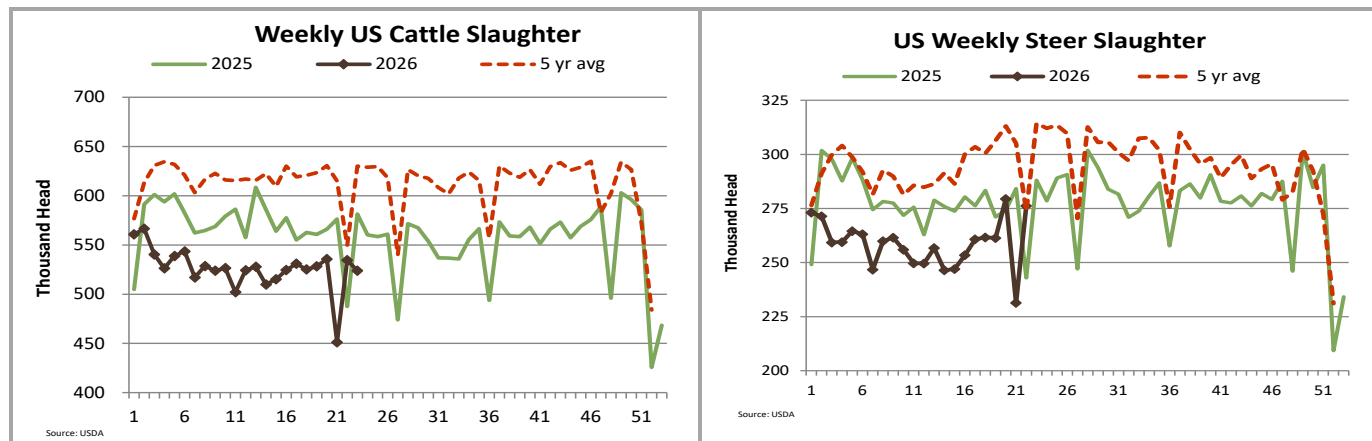

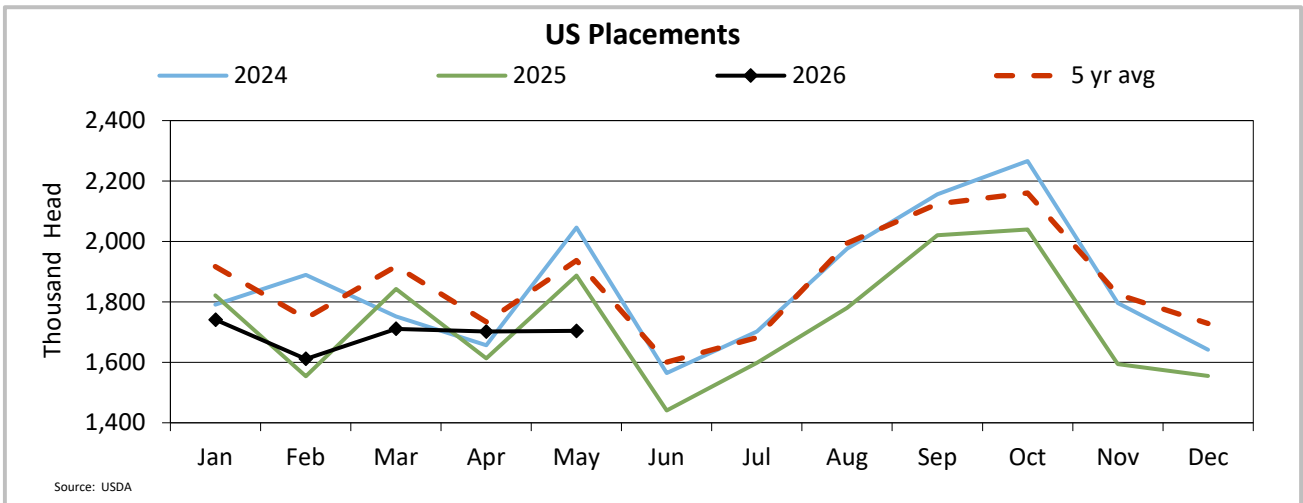

Comments for the week ending June 18, 2026

Fed steers and heifers sold through auction markets at 684 head, were down 159 head from the previous week and 230 head larger than the same time last year. Fed steers averaged \$345.50/cwt, up \$4.87/cwt from the previous week's trade and \$31.89/cwt above year ago prices. Fed heifers averaged \$346.35/cwt, up \$3.60/cwt from the previous week and \$37.66/cwt higher than last year. Auction markets reported that fed steers and heifers sold at steady prices.

In Ontario dressed sales were at \$570/cwt delivered, steady with the previous week. Cattle that traded were being scheduled for delivery in 1-2 weeks. For the week ending June 20, 2026, Eastern Canadian processing was down 7.2% from a year ago and 1.0% higher than the five-year average. YTD processing is down 2% from a year ago, with steers down 2% and heifers up 1%, cows down 5% and bulls down 22%. For the week ending June 6, 2026, Eastern fed cattle and cow exports to the U.S. were 3,651 head, 17% above last year and 45% above the five-year average. YTD Eastern fed cattle and cow exports were down 2% from last year.

Cull cow receipts sold through auction markets were 1,753 head, 93 head larger than the previous week and up 33 head from last year. Cows averaged \$218.91/cwt, down \$2.95/cwt from the previous week and up \$33.42/cwt from last year. Beef cow prices averaged \$232.20/cwt, down \$7.80/cwt from the previous week's trade and \$24.95/cwt above year ago prices. A good run of cull cows sold higher on good demand at Denfield.

Total receipts were 7,928 head with receipts of 3,388 stocker and feeder cattle selling through Ontario auction markets, up 294 head from the previous week and 756 head less than the same week last year. Auction markets reported that all classes of stocker and feeder cattle sold fully steady. In the feeder market, steer prices were up \$11.76/cwt on average compared to last week with heifers up \$0.11/cwt. Actual average prices collected this week saw steers from 400-500 lbs trading \$78.02/cwt stronger than last week on average, 500-600 lbs down \$9.94/cwt, 600-700 lbs up \$8.55/cwt, 700-800 lbs up \$12.95/cwt, 800-900 lbs down \$3.52/cwt, steers 900-1000 lbs down \$8.55/cwt and steers 1000 lbs plus averaged \$4.81/cwt stronger than the previous week's weighted average prices. Heifers from 300-400 lbs were down \$66.48/cwt from last week on average, 400-500 lbs up \$35.43/cwt, 500-600 lbs up \$6.11/cwt, 600-700 lbs up \$21.81/cwt, 700-800 lbs up \$11.59/cwt, 800-900 lbs up \$7.77/cwt and heifers 900 lbs and over averaged \$15.49/cwt weaker than the previous week's weighted average prices. For the week ending June 6, 2026, Eastern feeder exports to the U.S. were 653 head, steady with last year and 20% above the five-year average. YTD Eastern feeder exports are down 3% from last year.

The Quebec electronic market this week sold at \$569.00-569.00/cwt dressed on a picked-up basis, down \$0.50/cwt from the previous week's trade on average.

Alberta direct trade last week saw dressed sales in Alberta and Saskatchewan from \$575-590/cwt delivered. Cattle that traded would be picked up anywhere from 1-6 weeks. Sales at the top end of the range (\$590/cwt delivered) would be picked up in 1-2 weeks. After trending higher over the past five months, fed prices seem to have leveled off. Western Canadian fed prices continue to trade on either side of \$350/cwt, hovering near record highs. For the week ending June 13, 2026, Western Canadian fed processing was 33,727 head. YTD processing is 2% lower than last year. On June 12th, JBS announced the planned closure of the beef production facility in Souderton, Pennsylvania. The plant is set to close by August 14th.

U.S. trade last week saw dressed sales in Nebraska and Iowa from \$402-405/cwt, steady to a couple dollars lower than the previous week. Live sales in all major feeding states were \$255/cwt, steady to \$1/cwt weaker. US beef exports for the month of April were 19% below last year. YTD US beef exports are down 19% compared to 2025. US beef imports in April were 10% larger than last year. The largest supplier of beef to the US was Brazil. YTD Brazil accounts for 23% of total beef imports. Choice cutouts ended the week around \$0.50/cwt stronger than last week at \$393.21/cwt, with Select down \$10/cwt to \$373.25/cwt. Fatty 50% trim drifted \$2/cwt lower than last week, while 73% ground climbed \$24/cwt higher.

From a global perspective, corn production remains historically large with record production forecasted for Brazil. From their recent highs in May, the December 2026 corn contract has declined sixty cents per bushel, setting new contract lows. The weather and war premium has come out of the grain markets.
