The US cash cattle trade was light to moderate on Wednesday afternoon with prices under pressure. Sales in the south were steady to Tuesday at \$116.00 live, but down \$4.00-\$5.00 from last week. A light trade in the north on Wednesday was from \$184.00-\$186.00 dressed, down \$9.00-\$11.00 from last week. However, today things are looking a little better with a couple of sales in the north surfacing at \$190.00 dressed, which is \$4.00 higher than yesterday's trade but still \$5.00 lower than last week. Asking prices are stronger today at \$118.00-\$120.00 live in the south and \$192.00 dressed in the north. Business will continue into Friday.
