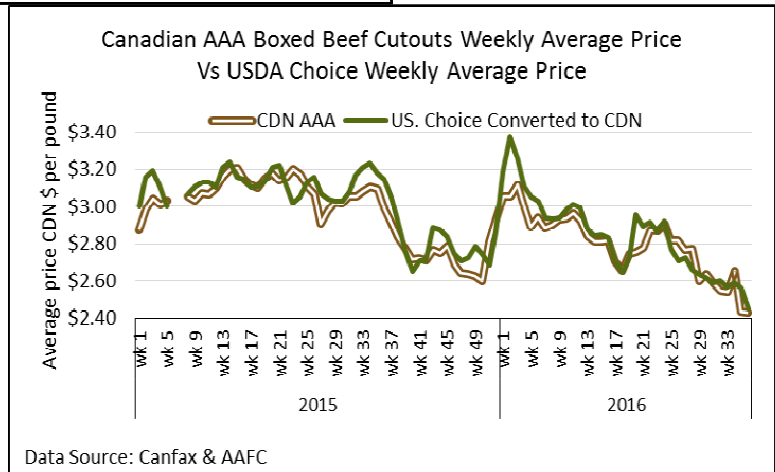
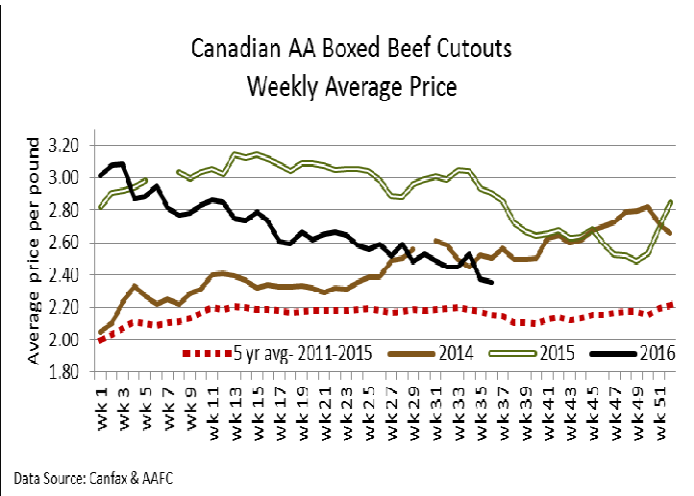
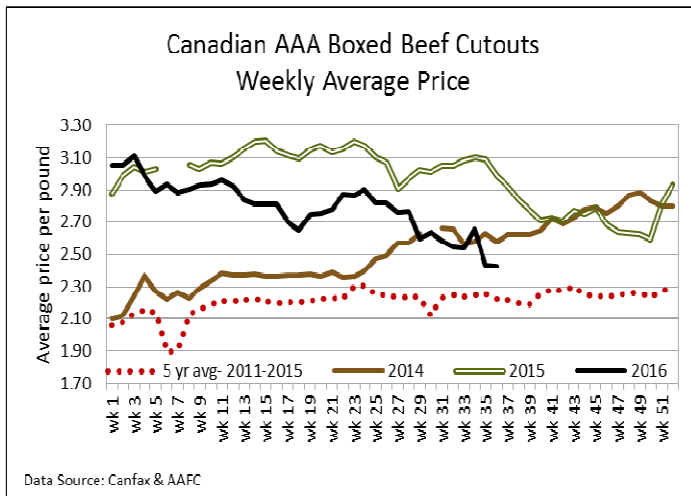

**U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)**

The U.S. cash cattle trade was active on Friday with higher prices. The USDA Mandatory Price Report listed live sales from \$105.00-\$110.00 with steers averaging \$109.36 up \$4.34 from the previous week, while live heifers averaged \$109.47 up \$4.59. On the rail steers and heifers traded from \$167.00-\$171.00 dressed, with steers averaging \$169.89 up \$3.64 from the week before, while heifers averaged \$169.99, up \$2.86. Today the market was quiet as new show lists were distributed. This week's offering is smaller in the south and larger in the north. Asking prices are undefined but are expected to be stronger than last week.
