ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade was untested on Tuesday, but some scattered trade could develop this afternoon. Canfax notes that asking prices are sitting around \$282.00-\$284.00 delivered on a dressed basis, with ready supplies reported as current which could lend support to the market.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

On the Fed Cattle Exchange online auction in the US this morning there was a total of 711 head (seven lots) of fed cattle on offer, with just four lots totaling 401 head, selling at \$119.00 live.

The U.S. cash cattle trade has been light to moderate on Monday and Tuesday, with live sales ranging from \$118.00-\$121.00, with steers averaging \$120.00 down \$1.50.00-\$2.00 from last week. Dressed deals ranged from \$190.00-\$195.00 averaging \$192.08 down \$1.75-\$2.00 from last week's weighted average. Today a couple of clean up sales were noted at \$120.00 live, otherwise the market was quiet and it appears that the bulk of this week's trade is completed.
