



- There was a high quality offering of 657 stockers comprised of 384 steers and 273 heifers with 95% of the cattle being vaccinated. Bidding was generally strong and consistent with most weight categories for both steers and heifers showing a significant advantage over the general Ontario market with exceptional demand shown for fancy light weight calves. There were 27 purchasing buyers and 51 consignors.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade last week continued from Tuesday to Friday, with prices generally steady to \$1.00 higher. Live sales in the south were \$126.00-\$127.00, mostly \$127.00, while live sales in the north ranged were generally \$126.00-\$128.00, most at \$128.00. Dressed deals in the north ranged from \$202.00-\$208.00. Actual average prices for the week, posted by the USDA Mandatory Price Report, saw live steers at \$127.91 up \$1.11 on average from the previous week, while heifers averaged \$127.68 up \$1.08. On the rail steers averaged \$205.47 up \$1.59 from the week before, while heifers averaged \$205.48 up \$1.28. Today the market was very quiet as both sides took inventory and new show lists were distributed. This week's offering appears to be slightly larger than last week in volume with the exception of Kansas, which has lighter volumes. Asking prices and bids are unestablished as futures were sharply lower. Both buyers and sellers will be sitting back and watching the board's direction before pricing any cattle.
