



U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle last week continued to trend lower, with live sales for the week, reported by the USDA Mandatory Price Report, from \$114.00-\$120.00 live with steers averaging \$116.73 down \$4.23 from the previous week on average, while heifers averaged \$117.63 down \$3.29. On the rail prices ranged from \$184.00-\$192.00 dressed, with steers averaging \$187.74 down \$4.58 from the previous week on average, while heifers averaged \$187.19 down \$5.38.

Today, the market was quiet as both sides took inventory and new show lists were distributed. This week's offering is reported to be larger in volume than last week, especially in Texas. Bids and asking prices are unestablished at this time, with little business expected before Wednesday.

Agcenter.com reports: "The tariff issues will be on the front burner for some time to come. Announcements are followed by comment periods and comment periods by 6 months of more vetting at world trade tables and finally behind the scene negotiations with each side hoping to reconcile inequities perceived from their own perspective. The day to day rumblings and posturings probably mean less than their impact."
