#### ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade on Tuesday remained at a standstill, however some scattered deals are expected to develop today. Asking prices are around \$250.00 delivered, on a dressed basis. Canfax reports: "This week's showlist has been compiled volumes steady with the previous week. With the lower Canadian dollar and stronger live cattle futures this morning technical prices levels have improved from the beginning of the week. Canfax released its May 1st cattle on feed report on Friday. April placements were down over 10% compared to last year while fed cattle marketings were up 15%. Cattle on feed inventories are now below last year."

### U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

At the Fed Cattle Exchange online auction in the US this morning there were 225 head of fed steers on offer, in just two lots which is reported as the smallest offering to date, online. Both lots were asking \$112.00 live for delivery in 1-9 days, but no bids developed and both lots were unsold.

The cash cattle trade remains untested for the week. A couple of bids surfaced today in Nebraska at \$108.00 live and \$175.00 dressed but sellers showed no interest. Asking prices are reported at \$115.00-\$116.00 live in the south and \$185.00 plus dressed in the north. Active trade should develop tomorrow if both sides want to get business out of the way early, before the long weekend.
