





ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade remains untested. Canfax reports: "The showlist for this week is smaller than the previous week with a moderate cash offering. Feedlot asking prices are expected to start out in the mid \$250's. Business is not anticipated until Wednesday."

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The US cash cattle trade results for last week were posted this afternoon by USDA's Mandatory Price Report. Volumes were very light with trade for the week ranging from \$107.00-\$115.00 live, with steers averaging \$110.06 down \$4.67 from the previous week on average, while heifers were \$110.04 down \$4.04 on average. On the rail sales for the week ranged from \$170.00-\$182.00 dressed, with steers averaging \$178.33 down \$5.69 from the previous week, while heifers averaged \$178.83 down \$4.16. Today the market was very quiet as both sides took inventory and new show lists were distributed. This week's offering is larger than last week, especially in Nebraska and Kansas. Asking prices are unestablished. Active trade is not expected to develop before Wednesday at the earliest.
