# U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade last week did not develop until late Friday afternoon, with an easier market noted. Friday saw trade in the south from \$107.00-\$110.00 live while dressed deals in the north ranged from \$170.00-\$174.00 dressed. The USDA Mandatory Price report listed live steers at \$108.74 on average from the previous week, down \$2.54, while live heifers averaged \$108.71 down \$3.23. On the rail steers averaged \$173.21 down \$4.34 from the previous week on average, while heifers averaged \$173.43 down \$5.37.

Today was untested as both sides took inventory and new show lists were distributed. This week's offering is reported to be smaller in volume in all feeding states. Both bids and asking prices are unestablished at this time and could stay that way until mid-week. The cattle futures were expected to be under pressure starting out this week and they certainly were. The downward pressure is reported to be as a result of lower trade on the cash market last week paired with the intensifying trade war between the U.S. and China, concerns of beef demand moving forward as well as the negative impact of a higher June 1st Cattle On Feed Report. Both sides will be keeping a very close eye on the board before setting any prices.
