#### ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

**Alberta direct trade** remains untested. Canfax reports: "This week's showlist has been compiled with volumes smaller than the previous week. Looking at the most recent weekly export data. Canadian fed cattle exports to the US totaled just over 3,800 head, volumes are 22% smaller compared to the same week last year." Asking prices are reported around \$246.00-\$247.00 delivered on a dressed basis.

### U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The US cash cattle trade saw a handful of trade yesterday in the north from \$170.00-\$172.00 dressed down around \$2.00 from last week but not enough to establish a market. A light test in the south was about steady from \$108.00-\$110.00 live. Today the market saw no new trade to report however bids were sitting at \$105.00 live in the south and \$172.00 dressed in the north. Asking prices are poorly defined. Active trade could be delayed until Thursday or Friday.
