ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade remains untested, but Canfax notes that the market tone is easier. Canfax reports: "Dressed bids have been reported from 235.00-236.00 delivered. Bids are 10.00 lower than last week. No live bids have been reported however using a 60% dressing percentage, dressed bids are working back to the low 140's on a live basis. Many producers are looking for at least steady money with last week. If bids do not improve today lots of cattle will be carried into next week."

The U.S cash cattle trade saw activity develop in the North today. As DTN reported: "Generally speaking dressed and live prices have improved as the day wore on. Most live sales appear to be around \$110 to \$111, \$2 to \$3 lower basis Nebraska. Dressed deals have ranged between \$176 and \$179, with the weighted average probably around \$178, near steady with last week basis Nebraska. Buying interest has not yet developed in the South, and we assume such action will be delayed until sometime Friday."
