ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade remains untested so far this week. Canfax reports that this week's offering is steady to last week in volume. Asking prices have been noted at \$257.00 plus cwt, delivered on a dressed basis. Canfax released the October 1st Cattle ON Feed report for Alberta and Saskatchewan. Canfax reports "The October 1, 2018 cattle on feed inventories are 18% larger than last year. This is the largest October 1st cattle on feed inventory since 2008."

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The US cash cattle trade saw a couple of starter bids surface today in Nebraska at \$172.00-\$174.00 dressed, but no sales were reported. Asking prices are currently unestablished. Active trading is not expected to develop before the second half of the week.
