ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade on Wednesday was very light with a few sales reported at \$148.50 live for steers which is fully steady to last week, as reported by Canfax. Asking prices are sitting at \$255.00-\$257.00 delivered on a dressed basis, but Canfax reports bids are only at \$248.00-\$250.00 cwt and are not getting any cattle bought.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S cash cattle trade was fairly quiet early week, which was unexpected due to the Thanksgiving Holiday in the U.S. on Thursday. A light test on Tuesday ranged from \$112.00-\$116.50 live averaging \$114.00-\$116.00 live, while a couple of sales in the north ranged from \$178.00-\$180.00 dressed which is up \$1.00-\$3.00 from last week, but not nearly enough to establish a market. There are reports that trade late Wednesday, after the Cattle On Feed Report was released, was from \$116.00-\$117.00 live on several thousand head in the south, up around \$3.00 from last week, while trade in the north was reported at \$180.00 dressed up \$2.50 from last week's average. Final results for Wednesday's trade is not available at this time due to the holiday. Asking prices have been bumped up to \$118.00-\$120.00 live in the south with asking prices in the north now unestablished. Business should continue on Friday but the actual volumes sold and left to sell are currently unknown.

The USDA Cattle on Feed Report released Wednesday reported the November 1st on feed inventories up 3% from last year, however marketings in October were up 5% compared to 2017, and placements were down 6% in October 2018 compared to 2017. The market viewed this report as positive, as prices on the cash market were stronger after its release.
