#### ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

**Alberta direct trade** is reported as very quiet by Canfax, however some scattered trade is possible this afternoon. Canfax reports that asking prices are sitting at \$272.00-\$277.00 cwt delivered on a dressed basis.

### U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw a handful of sales yesterday from \$122.00-\$123.00 live, down \$1.00-\$2.00 from last week on average, and \$196.00-\$197.00 dressed, but not enough to establish any kind of market. Today a few bids have resufaced at \$122.00 live in the south and \$196.00 dressed in the north, but sellers are showing no interest. Bids are holding at \$126.00 plus live in the south and \$200.00 plus dressed in the north. Business is not expected to develop until Thursday.

At the Fed Cattle Exchange online auction today there were 4,139 head on offer, in 26 lots with delivery in 1-9 days for all lots except one which was for 1-17 days. Two lots, one from Kansas and one from Texas, were asking \$123.00 live with both receiving bids of \$123.00, but only one lot sold with the other seller passing over the bid. All remaining lots were from Nebraska, with asking prices from \$124.00-\$125.00, majority at \$125.00. No bids occurred leaving cattle from Nebraska, unsold.
