ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade remains at a standstill, however some trade could start to develop this afternoon. Canfax reports "Technical price levels have improved from the beginning of the week. Packers were indicating cattle that they bought last week would not be lifted for one month. If lift dates stay four weeks out there will be additional pressure to market cattle to keep weights under control." Canfax reports that asking prices are sitting around \$268.00-\$270.00 delivered on a dressed basis.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade remains untested, with just a couple of starter bids noted in Kansas at \$121.00 live, with no selling interest reported. Asking prices are sitting at 126.00-\$127.00 live in the south and \$201.00-\$203.00 dressed in the north. Trade could start to surface tomorrow but active trade is not expected to develop until Friday.

At the Fed Cattle Exchange online auction today there were 294 head on offer, in 4 lots with delivery in 1-9 days. Asking prices were from \$123.00-\$124.00 live, with two lots selling for \$124.00-124.25, another lot passing bids of 124.00 and one lot with no bids.
