Canfax notes that due to the very large cash trade last week, feedlots are not under pressure to sell, which could limit sale volumes this week. Canfax reports: "No live bids have been reported however using a $60 \%$ dressing percentage, dressed bids are working back on either side of 150.00 on a live basis. Selling interest remains limited, many producers are looking for at least steady money with last week."
