ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade on Wednesday was easier than last week with Canfax noting sales from \$245.00-\$248.00 delivered on a dressed basis, down \$5.00-\$10.00 cwt from last week. Canfax notes that due to the very large cash trade last week, feedlots are not under pressure to sell, which could limit sale volumes this week. Canfax reports: "No live bids have been reported however using a 60% dressing percentage, dressed bids are working back on either side of 150.00 on a live basis. Selling interest remains limited, many producers are looking for at least steady money with last week."

The U.S cash cattle trade on Wednesday was light to moderate in the south and moderate to active in the north. Sales in lowa were the highest, reported from \$116.00-\$118.00 live and \$185.00-\$187.00 dressed. Overall trade in the south was from \$114.00-\$115.00 live down \$1.00-\$2.00 from the previous week. Dressed trade in the north ranged from \$181.00-\$187.00 with the lower prices for delayed delivery. Most of Wednesday's trade in the north ranged from \$184.00-\$185.00 dressed, which is steady to \$1.00 lower than last week. Today, a couple of sales are reported in parts of the north at \$116.00 live which is steady to yesterday. Otherwise, the market is quiet and it appears that the bulk of this week's trade has been completed.
