#### ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

**Alberta's direct trade** saw light activity develop on Thursday. Canfax reported, "...dressed prices fully steady with Wednesday at \$245/cwt delivered. Weighted average prices slipped \$1.50/cwt and \$2.50/cwt lower than the previous week on steers and heifers respectively. Packers have secured fed inventory out to the first half of July but feedlot supplies remain cautiously current."

Alberta direct trade for the week ending May 30, 2019 saw live steers traded at \$144.00 and dressed steers traded from \$242.00-\$246.50. Heifers traded from \$242.00-\$250.00 dressed.

### U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle market on Thursday saw moderate trade develop across the country. According to Canfax, live deals were priced at \$115.00 in the South and \$116.00 in the North, generally steady to last week's weighted average prices. The majority of dressed deals were reported at \$186.00 delivered, steady to \$1.00 higher than the previous week's prices. Today, asking prices were around \$116.00-\$117.00 live and \$188.00 dressed. Bids were at \$115.00 live and \$186.00 dressed. However, it appears that the majority of business has concluded for the week.

US Trade for the week ending May 30, 2019 saw live steers trade from \$114.00 - \$118.00 and live heifers from \$114.00 - \$119.00. Dressed steers ranged from \$184.00 - \$188.00 and dressed heifers from \$184.00 - \$187.00
