In the U.S. cash cattle trade last week, moderate trade activity developed. Canfax noted: "...live prices trending \$1-2/cwt lower than the previous week with most sales at \$110/cwt. Dressed sales in the North traded widely with prices around \$3-4/cwt lower than the previous week's Nebraska average. The bulk of rail sales were at \$180-181/cwt delivered."

Today, the market was quiet as both sides take inventory and new show lists are distributed. Bids and asking prices are not yet established.
