ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade remains untested. Canfax reports that this week's offering is larger in volume than last week with asking prices reported around \$240.00 cwt delivered, on a dressed basis.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The US cash cattle trade saw 61 head sell yesterday according to the USDA Mandatory Report, with 41 head at \$113.00 live and 20 head at \$110.00 live, but not nearly enough to establish any kind of trend. Today a couple of bids in the north surfaced at \$178.00 dressed but sellers were not interested. Asking prices remain unestablished, however the strength in the cattle futures today could encourage sellers to push asking prices higher than expected. Active trade is not expected to develop before the second half of the week.
